**GALLOWAY MOUNTAIN RESCUE TEAM  
PRESS RELEASE**

**Incident at Corsock House – Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2009**

About 7.30pm on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2009 Galloway Mountain Rescue Team were called to assist other emergency services at an incident at Corsock House near Castle Douglas. A 67 year old man had failed to return home after working near water on the estate.

The team deployed a cadre of our trained ‘Swift Water Rescue Technicians’ to assist with the search and rescue operations.

His body was found in the sluice of a hydro electric system prior to the arrival of the team personnel.
